

The Splicing

32 Bar Jig/Strathspey/Reel Medley in a 5 couple set

Devisor: John Drewry for David Sholtz's marriage to Mackenzie

The dance is usually a jig 5 times through.

1-8 1's & 3's turn by the RIGHT hand half way, promenade down two places, cross women in front and cast up one place to face 1st corners

WHILE: 2's & 4's set and cast up one place

9-16 1's pass 1st corners by the RIGHT shoulder and dance round them to meet partner up and down the middle and pull back RIGHT shoulder and cast round partners' 2nd corner to end on side of the set in 2nd and 4th places respectively

17-24 1's & 3's figure of 8 ACROSS the set (1W and 3M giving R hands in crossing up and down the first time and L the second)

WHILE: 2's, 4's & 5's set and cross over giving R hands the 1st time, L hands the 2nd

25-32 1's & 3's set advancing, balance in line (ala Wild Geese), turn partner R $\frac{3}{4}$ and cast down one place. 4's & 5's step up 31-32
