

LOCHANSIDE

Scottish

4 couple longwise (an old Highland dance in $\frac{3}{4}$ time collected by Mary Isdale MacNab)

- A1 all walk steps, join hands and balance in line, all pass partner right and dance to partner's place
- A2 repeat
- B1 all advance and retire with pas de basque and walk 6 steps to change places with partner and repeat to original places
- B2 1's face 2's and 3's face 4's and repeat B1
- C1 1's with 2's and 3's with 4's right hands across $\frac{1}{2}$ way, W under men's arch and cast around them (M move forward and back to help the W) and repeat with L
- C2 2's & 3's repeat C1
- C3 all repeat C1
- A1 all join hands and long pas de basque R & L and change places with partner 6 walking steps and repeat to original place, all face up
- B1 1's followed by 2's, 3's and 4's cast off for 4 pas de valse steps, all walk up to original places but in center
